ASCENSION OF THE LORD

MAY 21, 2023

-At the Crossroad- Feast of the Ascension of the Lord

1. First Reading: Acts 1:1-11

Luke, the historian, links the Acts of the Apostles with the Third Gospel. He already established his style of writing history: from the perspective of the poor, the marginalized, the victims who in Jesus share the ultimate victory and vindication: God is on the side of the poor, and theirs is the new life in the resurrection. The second part of his history is addressed to Theophilus, which means "friend of God". So, this is addressed to us, friends of God. There are three moments in this second part of the Gospel as history: (a) the forty days, which symbolize the time of uncertainty, doubt, confusion, trials and faith; (b) the time prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit. In those forty days, Jesus asserted his presence as the Risen Lord, whom the disciples could touch and talk with. In the time prior to the coming of the Holy Spirit, Jesus instructed them to wait in Jerusalem for the coming of the Holy Spirit. In between these two moments, there is the (c) Ascension of the Lord to heaven, dramatically described by Luke (cf. Luke 24:51). Jesus did not leave us behind alone as orphans. He is somewhere there in the clouds. But his presence is felt and known to us on earth because of the Presence of the Holy Spirit. He reigns with the Father in Heaven; on earth the task of Evangelization with the guidance and strength of the Holy Spirit has just begun. The poor of the earth whom Jesus called and with whom he shared his identity – the Church of the Poor - are in charge of this mission of Evangelization.

2. Responsorial Psalm: Ps 47:2-3, 6-7, 8-9

This is a hymn of praise or exultation of the Divine Kingship. It has two parts: (a) rejoicing over the universal kingship, and (b) rejoicing over the Lord's kinship over all the nations on earth.

3. Second Reading: Eph 1:17-23

This is Paul's prayer for the Ephesian Christian Community. Everything was already revealed in Jesus Christ. To understand this revelation – faith in Jesus and love of neighbor – Paul is praying that the Ephesian community receive the gift of the Spirit of Wisdom and Revelation. The place to receive the Holy Spirit is the center of the human person: the heart. It is from the heart (a) that we know hope as the anchor of our calling, (b) that we appreciate the riches of the heritage of those who follow Jesus in his pov-



erty, powerlessness and self-giving, (c) that we understand God's love and power in the Paschal Mystery, (d) that we are able to accept Jesus as the sole ruler of the universe and finally, (e) that we can see in the Church – the Christian Community – the gift of salvation as a gift for the whole community, and not for an individual, for we are one Body with Jesus as our Head.

4. Gospel: Mt 28:16-20

This is Matthew's Christology and Ecclesiology, for which he wrote his gospel. Jesus is again in Galilee where his life and ministry began. This time as Risen Lord with his disciples – the ecclesiology – a new community, the early church that worshiped him even when there was doubt. The Christology: Jesus alone has the authority from the Father to send the disciples to a universal mission of – the ecclesiology – baptizing all nations in the community of love that there is in the Trinity, making them "disciples of Christ". The Christology: in the beginning of Matthew's Gospel, God is with us – Emmanuel; at the end of his Gospel, Jesus says, "I am with you always, until the end of the age." – Fr. Ben, MSC

ASCENSION DEL SEÑOR

MAYO 21, 2023

-En La Encrucijada- Fiesta de la Ascensión del Señor

1. Primera Lectura: Hechos 1:1-11

Lucas, el historiador, relaciona los Hechos de los Apóstoles con el Tercer Evangelio. Ya estableció su estilo de escribir la historia: desde la perspectiva de los pobres, los marginados, las víctimas que en Jesús comparten la victoria y la reivindicación últimas: Dios está del lado de los pobres, y de ellos es la vida nueva en la resurrección. La segunda parte de su historia está dirigida a Teófilo, que significa "amigo de Dios". Entonces, esto va dirigido a nosotros, amigos de Dios. Hay tres momentos en esta segunda parte del Evangelio como historia: (a) los cuarenta días, que simbolizan el tiempo de la incertidumbre, la duda, la confusión, las pruebas y la fe; (b) el tiempo anterior a la venida del Espíritu Santo. En esos cuarenta días, Jesús afirmó su presencia como el Señor Resucitado, a quien los discípulos podían tocar y hablar. En el tiempo previo a la venida del Espíritu Santo, Jesús les instruyó que esperaran en Jerusalén la venida del Espíritu Santo. Entre estos dos momentos, está la (c) Ascensión del Señor al cielo, dramáticamente descrita por Lucas (cf. Lc 24,51). Jesús no nos dejó solos como huérfanos. Él está en algún lugar allí en las nubes. Pero su presencia es sentida y conocida por nosotros en la tierra debido a la Presencia del Espíritu Santo. Él reina con el Padre en el Cielo; en la tierra acaba de comenzar la tarea de la evangelización con la guía y la fuerza del Espíritu Santo. Los pobres de la tierra a los que Jesús llamó y con los que compartió su identidad, la Iglesia de los Pobres, son los encargados de esta misión de evangelización.

2. Salmo responsorial: Sal 47,2-3, 6-7, 8-9

Este es un himno de alabanza o exaltación de la Realeza Divina. Tiene dos partes: (a) regocijo por el reinado universal, y (b) regocijo por el parentesco del Señor sobre todas las naciones de la tierra.

3. Segunda lectura: Ef 1, 17-23

Esta es la oración de Pablo por la comunidad cristiana de Éfeso. Ya todo fue revelado en Jesucristo. Para comprender esta revelación, la fe en Jesús y el amor al prójimo, Pablo ora para que la comunidad de Éfeso reciba el don del Espíritu de Sabiduría y Revelación. El lugar para recibir el Espíritu Santo es el centro de la persona humana: el corazón. Es de corazón (a) que conocemos la esperanza como ancla de nuestra vocación, (b) que apreciamos las riquezas de la herencia de los que siguen a Jesús en su pobreza, impotencia y entrega, (c) que comprendemos el amor y el poder de Dios en el Misterio Pascual, (d)



que somos capaces de aceptar a Jesús como el único soberano del universo y finalmente, (e) que podemos ver en la Iglesia – la Comunidad Cristiana – el don de la salvación como un don para toda la comunidad, y no para un individuo, porque somos un solo Cuerpo con Jesús como nuestra Cabeza.

4. Evangelio: Mt 28,16-20

Esta es la cristología y la eclesiología de Mateo, para las cuales escribió su evangelio. Jesús está nuevamente en Galilea donde comenzó su vida y ministerio. Esta vez como Señor Resucitado con sus discípulos - la eclesiología - una nueva comunidad, la iglesia primitiva que lo adoraba incluso cuando había dudas. La cristología: Solo Jesús tiene la autoridad del Padre para enviar a los discípulos a una misión universal de -la eclesiología- bautizar a todas las naciones en la comunidad de amor que hay en la Trinidad, haciéndolas "discípulas de Cristo". La cristología y la eclesiología: en el comienzo del Evangelio de Mateo, Dios está con nosotros – Emmanuel; al final de su Evangelio, Jesús dice: "Yo estaré con vosotros todos los días, hasta el fin de los tiempos". – Padre Ben, MSC



PREPARACION MATRIMONIAL EN ESPAÑOL

Hôm nay chúng ta mừng trọng thể Chúa Giêsu về trời. Nếu chúng ta lúng túng không biết phải cảm nghĩ thế nào về sự kiện này, chúng ta hãy học lấy tín hiệu từ các tông đồ của Chúa Giêsu. Những môn đồ này là những nhân chứng đầu tiên cho sự Thăng thiên, sau đó

trở về Giê-ru-sa-lem, nơi mà “họ thường xuyên ở trong đền thờ ngợi khen Thiên Chúa.” Những người bạn đồng hành lâu năm của Chúa Giêsu, họ chắc chắn cảm nghiệm nỗi đau buồn vì phải ly biệt thân xác với Chúa Giêsu. Tuy nhiên, họ liên tục ngợi khen Thiên Chúa. Họ chấp nhận kế hoạch của Thiên Chúa, mong chờ ngày Đức Giêsu Kitô tái lâm. Như bài đọc của chúng ta theo Trích Sách Tông Đồ Công Vụ khẳng định, Đức Giêsu Kitô sẽ trở lại để “mang lại ơn cứu rỗi cho những ai thao thức chờ đợi Ngài”. Tin mừng này gần như là hơi quá sức để tiếp nhận; Sách Tông Đồ Công Vụ giải thích rằng một thiền sú phải đánh thức các tông đồ khỏi sự sững sờ của họ, nhắc nhở họ bắt đầu tiến trình của Thiên Chúa. Các bài đọc hôm nay là do thần khí Thiên Chúa ban cho chính chúng ta, gửi chúng ta đến với niềm hy vọng hân hoan.

Mary in the Bible (3)

Mary's second appearance is with Elizabeth. The marvels wrought by the Spirit meet one another: Elizabeth in her old age and Mary in her youthful virginity are pregnant; John the Baptist and Jesus the Messiah recognize each other from their mothers' wombs. The Holy Spirit inspired both mothers to exclaim the glorious deeds of God: Elizabeth sees the blessedness of Mary and her baby; Mary exclaims the God that she believes in.

Mary, the liberated woman, the liberated humanity, now sings her "Magnificat", the summary of God's self-revelation. It is a revolutionary song that proclaims the God of contradiction and liberation, on the side of the poor, the marginalized, the oppressed. Mary is inviting us to sing this song with her and make this song real in our lives.

Contrary to common historiography that champions the point of view of the victor, the colonizer, the rich and the powerful, Luke with Mary and Elizabeth representing the marginalized, the periphery, is writing a new history from the perspective of these two women, the perspective of the poor, the marginalized, the periphery, the downtrodden. The births of John and of Jesus and their respective ministries, will be viewed from this angle.

Mary's third appearance in Luke's Gospel is in the nativity scene of Jesus. In a remote place of Bethlehem (literally, from the Hebrew: house of bread), the heavenly message of the birth of the Savior-Messiah-Lord is brought by an angel to the hosts of heaven and to the shepherds on earth. This is incredible! At that time, the shepherds were a despised class of poor people, most unreliable tellers of good news. Who can believe a shepherd's speech? And the shepherds are now led to Bethlehem, where Joseph and Mary are, to a baby lying in a manger, among the beasts of burden. Mary gets the great news about her baby from the shepherds' mouth, and she keeps all these things, "pondering them in her heart." - Fr. Ben, MSC



Maria en la Biblia (3)

La segunda aparición de María es con Isabel. Las maravillas obradas por el Espíritu se encuentran: Isabel en su vejez y María en su virginidad juvenil están embarazadas; Juan el Bautista y Jesús el Mesías se reconocen desde el vientre de sus madres. El Espíritu Santo inspiró a ambas madres a exclamar las gloriosas obras de Dios: Isabel ve la bienaventuranza de María y su bebé; María exclama el Dios en el que cree.

María, la mujer liberada, la humanidad liberada, canta ahora su "Magnificat", el resumen de la auto-revelación de Dios. Es un canto revolucionario que proclama al Dios de la contradicción y de la liberación, del lado de los pobres, los marginados, los oprimidos. María nos está invitando a cantar esta canción con ella y hacer que esta canción sea real en nuestras vidas.

Contrariamente a la historiografía común que defiende el punto de vista del vencedor, el colonizador, el rico y el poderoso, Lucas con María e Isabel representando a los marginados, la periferia, está escribiendo una nueva historia desde la perspectiva de estas dos mujeres, la perspectiva de los pobres, de los marginados, de la periferia, de los oprimidos. Los nacimientos de Juan y de Jesús y sus respectivos ministerios, serán vistos desde este ángulo.

La tercera aparición de María en el Evangelio de Lucas es en el pesebre de Jesús. En un lugar apartado de Belén (literalmente, del hebreo: casa del pan), el mensaje celestial del nacimiento del Salvador-Mesías-Señor es llevado por un ángel a las huestes del cielo y a los pastores de la tierra. ¡Esto es increíble! En ese tiempo, los pastores eran una clase despreciada de gente pobre, muy poco fiables narradores de buenas noticias. ¿Quién puede creer el discurso de un pastor? Y los pastores ahora son conducidos a Belén, donde están José y María, a un niño acostado en un pesebre, entre las bestias de carga. María recibe la gran noticia de su bebé de boca de los pastores, y guarda todas estas cosas, "meditándolas en su corazón". - P. Ben, MSC
