

SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

February 25, 2018

From the Desk of the Pastor:

"Jesus took Peter, James and his brother John and led them up a high mountain apart by themselves" Mk 9:2-10

Brothers and sisters, today's Gospel Lesson is the story of a peak experience in the life of Jesus and three of the Apostles. Jesus takes Peter, James and John "up on a high mountain by themselves." They have gone up the mountain "to pray," Mathew tells us.

Somewhere on the solitary slopes of this high mountain, Jesus and the three disciples have come to be alone for a time of prayer. Each has his own special need. Jesus has come to a turning point in His life and ministry. His enemies are pressing in on Him and he must decide whether to retreat from the Holy Land or go to Jerusalem and directly confront those who are plotting to kill Him. Jesus' need is to discern the Will of God in this matter: Am I doing the right thing? Am I making the right decisions? Am I fulfilling My life's purpose?

For Peter and the others, it is a time to seek guidance in their understanding of Jesus' mission. Only six days earlier, Peter had had his wonderful insight about Jesus: "You are the Messiah." But when Jesus began to talk about how the Messiah would have to suffer and die, Peter refused to listen. Since boyhood, Peter had heard that the Messiah would be a great, conquering military hero. Consequently, it was most difficult for him to accept Jesus as "Suffering Servant." "This shall never happen to You Lord," he said to Jesus. And Jesus severely rebuked him, saying, "Get behind Me, Satan! You are a hindrance to Me; for you are not on the side of God but of men" (Mt. 17:22, 23). Clearly, Peter and the others need to pray for guidance in this matter.

As Jesus and the others are praying, Moses (representing the Law) and Elijah (representing the prophets) appear to them and talk with them. Matthew wants us to understand that Jesus and the disciples are searching the deepest levels of their background and tradition in order to discover God's Will. And we can almost hear the voices of Moses and Elijah confirming what Jesus had said to Peter and the other disciples: "He's right! ... Listen to Him! Go with Him to Jerusalem regardless of the consequences."

This is an important lesson for us. God comes to us in a hundred different ways, but there is none more important than when He gives Himself to us directly and we experience His Living Presence in an intensely intimate way. Jesus and the Apostles had to be willing to climb the mountain in order to experience, in an intimate way, God's Living Presence. The experience was an end in itself, but still they needed to respond. Peter wanted to stay on the mountaintop. We can understand this. Some of have been on retreats that were so spiritually uplifting we didn't want to leave. Peter literally wanted to build some shelters and stay up there on the mountain. But Jesus ignored the suggestion and led the Apostles down the mountain and back into the valley. And what did they find? They found people in need. Immediately, they encountered a father pleading for his son: "Lord have mercy on my son for he is an epileptic and he suffers terribly" (Mt. 17:15).

SEGUNDO DOMINGO DE CUARESMA

25 de febrero, 2018

Del Escritorio del Párroco:

“Jesús, tomo aparte a Pedro, Santiago y Juan y subió con ellos a un monte alto y se transfiguró en su presencia” Marcos 9:2-10

Queridos hermanos y hermanas en Cristo, el evangelio de hoy es una lección de una experiencia clímax en la vida de Jesús y sus tres apóstoles. Jesús toma a Pedro, Juan y Santiago y subió a una montaña para orar.

En algún lugar de las lomas solitarias de esa montaña, Jesús y sus tres discípulos para orar. Cada uno de ellos tiene sus propias necesidades. Jesús ha llegado a un punto muy delicado de su ministerio y de su vida. Sus enemigos lo están presionando y él tiene que decidir si se queda en esa montaña para esconderse o va a Jerusalén a confrontarlos directamente. Jesús necesita discernir la voluntad de Dios en este momento difícil de su vida.

Para Pedro, Juan y Santiago es también una oportunidad para buscar la guía de Dios en su entendimiento de la misión del maestro Jesús. Seis días antes, Pedro había tenido esta grandiosa estimación de Jesús: “Tu eres el Mesías.” Pero una vez que Jesús comenzó a declarar que el Mesías tenía que sufrir y morir, Pedro se reveló. Desde pequeño, Pedro había escuchado que el Mesías vendría como un gran héroe militar que liberaría al pueblo de Israel. Por lo tanto, es entendible, que para él era muy difícil aceptar lo que Jesús decía, “Esto nunca te sucederá a ti, Señor.” Entonces, Jesús le reprocha, “aléjate de mí satanás. Tu no piensas como Dios sino como los hombres.” Así que, Pedro necesitaba urgentemente rezar.

Cuando Jesús y sus apóstoles están orando, Moisés (representante de la Ley), y Elías (representante de los Profetas) se aparecen y comienzan a dialogar con Jesús. El evangelista quiere que entendamos que Jesús y sus discípulos están recurriendo hasta lo más profundo de sus tradiciones religiosas para descubrir la voluntad de Dios. Casi podemos escuchar a Moisés y Elías confirmando lo que Jesús había dicho a Pedro y sus otros discípulos: “Jesús tiene la razón...” Escúchenlo! Vayan con él a Jerusalén sin importarles las consecuencias.”

Esta es una lección muy importante para todos nosotros. Dios viene a nosotros de muchas maneras diferentes, pero nunca como cuando llega de la manera más íntima. Y esto sucede cuando buscamos discernir su sagrada voluntad y la aceptamos, cueste lo que nos cueste.

Pedro quiso quedarse en la cima de la montaña. Muchos de nosotros podemos entenderlo al estar en retiros espirituales que nos nutren tanto que no queremos salir de ellos. Pedro quería construir tres tiendas, pero Jesús ignora su sugerencia y los guía de regreso hacia el valle de las necesidades y sufrimiento humano. Tan pronto bajaron, encontraron a un padre que le rogó a Jesús que lo sanara porque padecía de epilepsias y sufría mucho. Así también, tenemos que hacer nosotros.

HÃY VÂNG NGHE LỜI NGƯỜI

Từ đám mây, có tiếng Chúa Cha phán rằng: “Đây là Con Ta yêu dấu, hãy vâng nghe lời Người.” (Mc 9,7)

Suy niệm: Thông thường ta giới thiệu nhau khi mới gặp lần đầu hoặc quen biết nhau rồi, nhưng khuôn mặt bị phai mờ theo thời gian hay bị biến dạng cách nào đó, lúc ấy cần phải giới thiệu lại để người ta có thể nhận biết nhau cách chính xác. Cũng vậy, trong bối cảnh Chúa Giê-su chuẩn bị bước vào cuộc Khổ nạn, khi thân xác Ngài sẽ bị biến dạng bởi những cực hình do con người gây ra, Chúa Cha đã xuất hiện để giới thiệu: “*Đây là Con Ta yêu dấu.*” Lời khẳng định ấy thì cần thiết, bởi người ta quen nghĩ rằng những gì thuộc Thiên Chúa phải nguy nga, phải long lẫy, hoành tráng. Trong khi ấy Thiên Chúa lại hành động qua những gì thế gian cho hèn mạt, không đáng kể... (1Cr 1,27-29). Chính vì thế, cần phải có lời dẫn dò của Chúa Cha “*Hãy vâng nghe lời Người*” để các môn đệ có thể đứng vững trong cuộc Khổ nạn của Thầy mình.

Mời Bạn: “*Chúa Ki-tô hôm qua, hôm nay và mãi mãi vẫn là một*” (Dt 13,8). Ngài vẫn là Con yêu dấu của Cha, nhưng đồng thời, Ngài hiện diện giữa nhân loại qua những cách thế rất bình thường, nếu không muốn nói là tầm thường. Vì thế, nguy cơ vấp phạm về Ngài là rất cao. Liệu rằng chúng ta có dễ dàng “vâng nghe” tiếng của Ngài đang nói qua Bí tích Thánh Thể, qua Lời Chúa,

qua Giáo hội và qua những người bé mọn, nghèo hèn không?

Sống Lời Chúa: Tập cho mình thói quen dừng bao giờ thắc mắc “tại sao?” trước những hành động của Thiên Chúa. Nhưng nếu không hiểu thì hãy hỏi “việc ấy xảy ra thế nào?” để rồi đáp lời “xin vâng” như Đức Ma-ri-a.

Cầu nguyện: Hát bài “*Xin vâng.*”

Tuy nhiên, việc ngăn ngừa bị xâm hại, lạm dụng cần được cảnh báo cho cả nam lẫn nữ và cho họ biết “Phải lên tiếng”. “Phải tố cáo” khi thấy những tình huống nguy hiểm xảy ra và “Phải nói Không” với những tình huống này xảy ra cho mình. Chương trình “Bảo vệ trẻ em” chủ trương dạy các em cả nam lẫn nữ vì những nguy hiểm bị lạm dụng nhận ra được các dấu hiệu từ người lớn. Câu hỏi “WWJD” (Chúa Giêsu Làm Gì Trong Trường Hợp Này?) sẽ làm các em mạnh dạn lên tiếng tố cáo hay quyết tâm chạy xa những nguy hiểm và các em sẽ thay đổi tính tình trong tương lai để chặn đứng những điều xấu và các em không phải nhần nhục chịu đựng những điều xấu.
