Guidelines for Returning to Mass

As we prepare to return to public celebration of Mass, here are some guidelines to ensure the safety and well-being of our local Church.

Communion. Persons should come forward in a single communion line in the aisle designated at six-foot intervals, please look for ushers' signal. Masks may be removed prior to receiving the consecrated host in the hand. At this time, communion will be received in the hand only. Once received, step to the side and replace your mask.

Sanitation. All parishes will be sanitizing pews, entrances, restrooms, and all other facilities used regularly.

Attendance Capacity. Because seating is limited due to social distancing, you may be asked to attend at another time or view Mass by live streaming. For each Mass, attendees do not exceed more than 25% of any room capacity or 100 persons maximum, whichever is less. More details can be found on our website:

Guidelines for Mass Attendees

Maintain a social distance of six feet

Avoid all physical contact during Mass

Use personal hand sanitizer before receiving communion

Wear face masks at all times please remove when receiving communion

Please wait for a signal from the ushers to exit the church
